Citizens in Dorchester — and all over the nation — are marking National Preservation Month with a campaign dubbed “This Place Matters!” This week, a banner was unfurled across the front of the Lenane Building in Fields Corner with the help of volunteers from Historic Boston Incorporated, the Dorchester Historical Society, and Fields Corner Main Streets. Historic Boston’s Jeffrey Gonyeau, a Dorchester resident, stressed the importance of spreading the campaign to the neighborhood, saying “while many people recognize the importance of historic buildings downtown, it’s the historic fabric of Boston’s neighborhoods that truly make this city a special place.” Gonyeau credited Ira Schlosser of Dorchester House, which allowed for and helped coordinate the hanging of the banner on the organization’s flagship building.
